### Autumn Kasan Designs

**Autumn Kasan** is a Connecticut-based designer specializing in luxurious shoes that are hand-sculpted by American master artisans, bringing high-end, European-style craftsmanship back to the U.S. Autumn designed and constructed her first shoe in kindergarten, and created her first necklace in elementary school. She is founder of AutumnMarie.com, an online boutique inspired by her mother Phyllis Marie, that offers a curated collection of jewelry, accessories, gifts, and home items handcrafted by makers and artisans across the globe.

### Redington Designs

**Caitlin Redington** is a Boston-based designer who graduated Lasell University in 2016 with a degree in fashion design. She studied abroad at the London College of Fashion in the Fall 2014. At the London College of Fashion she learned and corsetry.
