PASTEL CLASS/WORKSHOP MATERIALS LIST

- Reference photos **that you have taken yourself**. These can be prints or you can use your iPad. (*No magazine clippings, photos from the internet, or photos taken by other people.*)
- Sanded pastel papers in warm colors such as burnt sienna, sand, olive green –
recommended: Canson Mi Tientes Touch, Art Spectrum Colorfix, Sennelier LaCarte.
**Experienced students may try PastelMat.*
- UArt pastel paper (off-white color) 320 or 400 grit (*This is critical – do not substitute another brand of white or off-white paper. Cut to pieces of 11 x 14” or 16 x 20” size.*) *Save the scraps.*
**Experienced students may also wish to use UArt Dark*
- Easel (*Either a standing easel or an adjustable table easel with a stable base if you prefer to sit*)
- Drawing board (*on which to mount your paper*)
- Artist tape or masking tape
- Sketchbook
- Drawing pencils or markers in at least 3 distinct values (*dark, medium, light*)
Recommended: Faber Castell 6 PITT Artist Pen shades of gray
- Assorted soft pastels (whatever brands you use) **NO OIL PASTELS.**
Recommended: Rembrandt, Unison, Sennelier half sticks, Terry Ludwig, Girault.
- 4 NuPastels or Jack Richeson hard pastel sticks for underpainting - dark purple, magenta, medium orange, and bright pink.
- Vine charcoal
- Rubbing alcohol in a wide mouth container with a tight screw-on lid
- 2 or 3 cheap watercolor brushes in different sizes
(I use “Simply Simmons” bristle bright set of 3 from Dick Blick)
- Baby wipes
- Paper towels
- An empty pastel box or something to set aside the pastels you choose for your palette
(Empty chocolate box, styrofoam box from food take-out, etc. work well for this purpose.)
- An old bath towel to serve as a dropcloth
